### THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK - VOCATIONS SUNDAY

This Sunday we focus on Jesus as the Good Shepherd. Another word for shepherd is pastor. The priests of the church are called to be pastors of their people. All of us are people of vocation. In Baptism we were called to be followers of Christ, members of his church and to continue the work and mission of Jesus. Pope Francis is adamant that all of us are called to mission. "Commitment to mission is not something added to Christian life as a decoration, but is instead an essential element of faith itself. A relationship with the Lord entails being sent out into the world as prophets of his word and witnesses of his love". So all of us are called to play our part in the work of the Church.

But there will always be a need for people who consecrate themselves totally to the mission and work of the church. At the present time there is a growing need for priestly and religious vocations to take on and continue the ministry of Christ. All of us are aware of that need and all of us as members of God's church have responsibility to pray for vocations and encourage suitable people to consider and discern a call to fulfil Christ's ministry in the church. Again, Pope Francis is eloquent about the role. "it is beautiful - and a great grace - to be completely and forever consecrated to God and the service of our brothers and sisters."

**Next Family Mass and Children's Liturgy will take place on Sunday 29th April at 12 Noon mass.**

**Next weekend 28th/29th April the Bishop** will send a pastoral letter for the consideration of the people of the diocese. Copies of the letter will be available in the Church so that we can all take them home after Mass. The diocese believes it is important that each of us carefully reflect upon the serious matter of removing the right to life of the unborn child in the Constitution and then allowing for terminations up to 12 weeks. You are invited to take the newsletter away and to read it closely.
